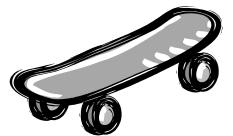

In 1845, the hand-cranked freezer was invented, allowing Americans to make ice cream more easily at home.

ALWAYS ON SUNDAY

The ice cream sundae emerged during the 1890s, and there are many claims for its invention. Contemporary laws forbade the sale of soda on Sunday, and this, undoubtedly, had a hand in popularizing the dessert. The first sundaes were sold in ice cream parlors only on Sunday, and thus were called "Sundays" or "soda-less sodas." The spelling change to "sundae" was made later by ice cream parlor proprietors eager to see the dish shed its Sunday only connotation.

During the **American Revolution**, the legal separation of the **Thirteen Colonies** from Great Britain in 1776 actually occurred on July 2, when the **Second Continental Congress** voted to approve a **resolution of independence** that had been proposed in June by **Richard Henry Lee** of **Virginia** declaring the United States independent from Great Britain rule. After voting for independence, Congress turned its attention to the **Declaration of Independence**, a statement explaining this decision, which had been prepared by a **Committee of Five**, with **Thomas Jefferson** as its principal author. Congress debated and revised the wording of the Declaration, finally approving it two days later on July 4

**Gum Disease and Your Heart**

The evidence of a link between gum disease and heart disease continues to grow. Researchers at Columbia University recently found that the bacteria that cause gum disease also seem to cause atherosclerosis, or narrowing of the arteries. Brushing at least twice a day and flossing at least once a day, along with limiting sweets, is the best way to keep your teeth and gums – and possibly your heart—healthy. Most toothbrushes last about three months. Once they've become worn or frayed, it's time to get a new one.



While popular lore claims that the ice cream cone was invented at the 1904 World's Fair in St. Louis, a New York City ice cream vendor actually seems to have created the cone in 1896 to stop customers from stealing his serving glasses. He patented the idea in 1903 and it took off in popularity at the World's Fair the next year.



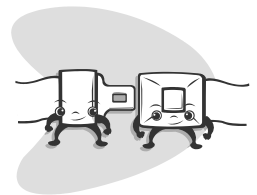

**CREATIVE TIPS FOR
THROWING AMAZING PARTIES**

Tiger, Tiger, Burning White...

One of the most entrancing, and beautiful members of the cat species, is the Bengal Tiger, with its deep orange coat, dark stripes, and glowing eyes.

The Bengal is found primarily in India, although they may range into nearby countries such as Bhutan, or Myanmar. The tiger's individual territory can be as large as 15-25 miles for males, or 6-15 miles for the female, who at sexual maturity, will have litters of 2-4 cubs.

Researchers estimate that one in every 10,000 wild Bengal births, is the very rare white tiger, a phenomenon that occurs only in the Bengal, and only from the mating of two tigers who carry the recessive albino gene. The offspring are referred to as chinchilla albinistic, because they are not "pure" albinos, which would have no pigment at all. The white tiger is typified by creamy fur, chocolate stripes, blue eyes and pink noses and paw pads.

We've all been to parties that have that certain something-special that makes them stand out in our memories as being truly fabulous. Of course, to have a great party, you need to start with great guests. Assuming you have that part covered, often it comes down to all of the little party details to really make a party special.

Here are a few fast but fabulous tips to put your parties on the map:

- Freeze strawberries or raspberries, then pop them into glasses of Sprite or 7-Up for a dash of "bling". The berries will kick it up a notch with a splash of color and class, and will inject an element of unexpected surprise.
- If the "powder room" your guests will visit during the party has a bathtub, glam things up by filling the tub with water, then float the heads of oodles of large scented flowers in it. Roses, gerbera daisies, mums, and carnations are all good choices. The stunning visual impact of this will knock the socks of your guests - and the room will smell amazing.
- Pick up simple store-bought cakes at the local grocery, then give them the high-end, lavish look of expensive custom cakes by embellishing them with fresh, non-poisonous flowers such as roses, pansies, or nasturtium.
- To encourage mingling at any party, limit the number of seats so that guests don't just plunk themselves down in one spot for the entire night. Some seating is, of course, necessary for those with weary feet, but there should be substantially fewer seats than guests if you want to keep things lively.

Take a Shine to Vitamin D

It doesn't take much sun to get all the vitamin D you body needs. Five to 10 minutes, several times a day (e.g., when you're running daily errands), will usually give you enough vitamin D to help protect you from rickets and osteoporosis (when combined with calcium). What if you're inside a lot, or live in a less-sunny, northern area? Take a daily multivitamin supplement, eat vitamin D-fortified cereal, and/or drink vitamin D-fortified milk.
